

APPLICATION FOR THE URBAN LEADER SCHOLARSHIP

Background: The late Gordon Lindsay and his wife, Freda, founded Christ For The Nations Institute in 1970. Gordon envisioned thousands of Spirit-filled believers going forth to do exploits for God around the world. After Gordon's passing in 1973, Mrs. Freda Lindsay followed the vision and the ministry is flourishing.

Statement of Purpose: The Christ for the Nations Urban Leader Scholarship has been established to reach out to the urban areas of the Dallas metroplex, to assist accepted African American urban males by providing financial assistance in the form of scholarships, and by so doing, to fulfill the vision of CFNI.

Scholarship Value:

Tuition Only (TO) Scholarship -

Covered - Tuition

Not Covered - Housing and associated costs (if living on campus), meals, books, extra-cost electives, SOWTA Technical Arts fee, deferment fees, registration fee, Student Activity Fee, other fees not listed as *covered* above.

Full Scholarship (FS) - (Personal Interview may be requested by committee)

Covered - Tuition, Student Activity Fee, registration fee, housing and associated costs, meals, books

Not Covered - Extra-cost electives, SOWTA/ Technical Arts fee, and other fees not listed as *covered* above.

Basis for Selection: Application for scholarship will be reviewed after acceptance to Christ For The Nations Institute by the CFNI Admissions department. To be eligible for the scholarship, applicant must be a United States citizen and resident of a Dallas metroplex urban area. A committee will review applications and acceptance will be based on this application as well as the Pastor's and Personal Recommendations from the applicant's file.

Length of Scholarship: The CFNI Urban Leader Scholarship is awarded on a **semester-by-semester basis** and may be awarded to a single applicant for a maximum of three years. Ongoing awarding of the scholarship will be reviewed and based on:

- ◆ Need
- ◆ Maintaining a 3.0 average for the current semester
- ◆ Attitude
- ◆ Obtaining no more than 200 attendance points per Spring or Fall semester
- ◆ Current financial status with the Institute
- ◆ Must not be on full probation with any department
- ◆ Dean recommendation.

Consideration for future Urban Leader Scholarships will end upon dismissal, withdrawal from any program.

Deadlines for Application: For the **Fall Semester, the deadline is June 1st**. For those students enrolling for a **Spring Semester, the deadline is October 1st**. Return scholarship applications to Admissions office.
